#### MESSAGE FROM THE HOA BOARD PRESIDENT - RUTH SOUTHARD

**September...**and it does not feel like the Falls I remember. But, then again, this is Houston, TX; it is supposed to be hot this time of year. We can be grateful the drought is over and there have been no hurricanes.

Speaking of the hurricanes, the Community Relations Committee (CRC) sponsored the annual severe storm seminar in June. We were all reminded once again to be prepared. It was a surprise to meet some homeowners who had never experienced a hurricane so we continue to find value in this annual exercise in preparedness.



The drought may be over but the impact of the rain has been felt community-wide. The landscaping crew had significant difficulty keeping up with the mowing and trimming and the work suffered. The Grounds Committee has worked tirelessly to correct this situation and we expect improved service in the future.

The lake apron repair was delayed due to the combination of a lot of rain in the early summer and work overload by the contractor.

The heat has been felt in several areas throughout the community over the past few months. The fence project is progressing steadily but we have had periodic halts due to a variety of things...heat being one of them. The whole project is projected to be complete before the end of the year. We have so many people to thank for making this enormous project go as smoothly as it has.

The new dumpster enclosure work was delayed but started up late summer and should be complete in the Fall.

The board projects include finalizing the Strategic Plan 2016-2021 and the 2016 budget. The community leadership team had an excellent workshop in June to initiate the process of reviewing and updating the plan. The Finance committee was challenged to prepare the 2016 budget with no increase in monthly assessments. Both documents are scheduled for approval in the next couple of months and will be posted to the website for homeowner access.

This is a really wonderful place to live thanks to the many, many committed people who do the work that makes our lives enjoyable.







## Strategic Planning Workshop plans for future

The annual Strategic Planning workshop was held on Saturday, June 27, 2015. For the first time, the meeting was held in BellaVita. For seven years we have accepted the generosity of the REMAX-Clear Lake office facilities for our workshop.

Each year the leadership team of BellaVita convenes for a full day. This team of volunteers is composed of the Board of Directors, committee chairs, club presidents, major task force facilitators, and the Clubhouse Manager. We meet both as a large group and small break-out groups to review completed projects, work in progress, and anticipated events. We discuss what we do well in the community and where we could make improvements. Without a plan there is no defined direction. The leadership team uses the plan to keep on track and on budget.

This year the open discussion centered around how to communicate better to homeowners not only what is happening but, more importantly, what it takes to get things done in the community. The HOA is organized into 10 committees each with specific functions/responsibilities. Each committee, composed of 4-15 people, meets at least once a month. Watch for some new ways we plan to use to highlight the work of the committees as well as recognizing the individual efforts of these volunteers. Homeowners are encouraged to participate in committee activity that matches your interest or skill set. Simply contact the committee chair.

New goals and revisions to the document are currently underway. The October Board workshop will focus on the Strategic Plan 2016-2021 with approval expected at the Board meeting in November. The Strategic Plan is available on the website under governing documents.


#### **MEET YOUR NEIGHBOR:**

#### A MAN WHO IS A CHAMPION FOR JUSTICE AND A SERVANT OF THE DISADVANTAGED

**Virgil Wood** is a remark-able man who has devoted his life to the service of others. He was born in Charlottesville, Virginia. He was educated at Virginia Union University, Andover

Newton Theological School and received his doctorate from Harvard. His career has included Dean at North Eastern University In Boston and 55 years as a pastor for various congregations.

He was one of the leaders of the Civil Rights Movement and worked closely with Martin Luther King while serving on the National Executive Board of the Southern Christian Leadership Committee. Dr. Wood was a Coordinator for



the March on Washington in 1963. He was a participant in the Civil Rights Marches on Birmingham, Selma, Danville, VA and St. Augustine and jailed three times. Three of his friends were murdered during the marches. The actions by Dr. Wood and other marchers led to the passage of the historic Civil Rights Bill by Lyndon Johnson. Later, Dr. Wood was a panelist for three White Conferences under the Johnson, Nixon and Carter Administrations. He has written 2 books: In Love We Trust, Lessons I Learned From Martin Luther King, and The Jubilee Bible.

Since he has "retired" Virgil Wood has continued his outreach to disadvantaged youth of all races. He does this by speaking to young people at schools and detention centers and stressing that "You are not your limitations and you are not your mistakes." He has lectured recently at NASA and Prairie View A&M University.

Virgil and Lillian, his wife, have been married for 62 years. He has two children, Deborah and David. Deborah lives here in BellaVita. The Wood's have 2 grandchildren and 1 great grandchild.

Dr. Virgil Wood is a special man who inspires everyone he meets and we are lucky to have him as a part of the BellaVita community.



I imagine that almost everyone in BellaVita has observed that there are four spray type water fountains located on our community's lakes. When observing these fountains have you ever wondered what the real purpose of these fountains might be?

The primary reason for using aeration fountains on lakes is to provide additional dissolved oxygen into the lakes water to promote a natural solution to water quality management. Dissolved oxygen is effective in controlling algae, aquatic weeds as well as helping to eliminate foul odors. Operating fountains also helps to deter insects such as mosquitoes and other unwanted insects from breeding. Fish and all aquatic life almost always do better in a lake or pond that contains sufficient oxygen. The spray configuration released from the fountain adds to the aesthetics of a lake view.

The fountains have water proof lighting that is set to come on during the nighttime hours. Here in BellaVita the fountain lights operate from 6:00-10:00 PM during the winter months and from 8-10 PM during the summer months. Lights are primarily used to accent the beauty of the fountain spray at night. The fountains are set to come on at 7:00 AM and to shut down at 10:00 PM for a total operating time of approximately 15 hours a day. This appears to be the optimum hours of operation for our lake conditions.

It costs approximately \$8 a day to operate each of the three larger fountains and approximately \$3.25 a day for the little lake fountain. Over a year's period of time we spend approximately \$28,000 to operate our four lake fountains. Not an insignificant amount of cost when looking at a full year.

There are also maintenance and electrical issues that need to be addressed during the year. It is not unusual to have our Lake Management firm on site 3-4 times a year to make necessary repairs to the fountains.

The cost of operation of these fountains keeps the facilities committee as well as the Club House staff busy ensuring cost effectiveness while still maintaining a responsible operating program. Numerous changes are required of the timing controls to meet changing seasons from both a temperature standpoint and dawn to dusk ariations over a year's time.


