

23d. Window Protection for Entire Hurricane Season (June 1st through November 30th): During hurricane season window protection covering may be installed for extended time periods and do not have to be associated with any particular storm. This type of solution must be harmonious with the materials used in construction of the residence. All window coverings that are installed for an extended time during hurricane season require ARC approval. Once a window covering is approved, it does not require additional approval each year.

23e. Window Protection for Single Hurricane Event: Window protection coverings that are installed for a specific hurricane are deemed to be temporary. Temporary window protection coverings may be installed only after the National Weather Service issues a “hurricane watch” for the area. The window protection coverings must be removed within two weeks after cancellation of the hurricane watch or the passage of the hurricane. The type of window protection material used for temporary coverings is left to the discretion of the homeowner and does not require ARC approval.
