Parking Lot Issues

The recent parking lot incident in which outsiders gained entry and had unauthorized use of our parking lot has been traced to a party house rented through Air BnB in the Villa D'Este subdivision. There was a report that the outside visitors had a resident code to enter the gates. Shannon has spent considerable time reviewing the gate entry codes and cannot find a repeating code which would evidence that a resident code was used for entry. Review of the camera footage does show several cars tailgating into the community during the times reported.

We all need to be vigilant of cars which attempt to tailgate behind our entry. Staff has been instructed to become more vigilant in observing activities in and around the clubhouse and parking lot. The Pearland Police Department are aware of the matter and an incident report has been filed. In addition, the City of Pearland has been notified that the owner of the property has resumed short-term rentals of the property for which a previous citation had been made.

The board of directors of Villas Master is committed to taking any action necessary to control the issue of the party house and will continue to monitor this matter. The Bella Vita board will also continue to work closely with Villas Master board, the management company and necessary officials regarding this incident.

To help us, if you are having guests who will be using the parking lot, please notify the office for a visitor card to be displayed on the dash of the car. We all must work together – <u>if you see something</u>, <u>say something</u>. Do not confront anyone that you think might not have gained appropriate access to the community but call the office if open or call the Pearland Police Department, non-emergency number to report. That number is 281-997-4100.





IMPORTANT HOMEOWNER NOTICE FOR IRRIGATION SYSTEM ADJUSTMENT FROM GROUNDS COMMITTEE

THE PROBLEM:

Rusticscapes has noticed early stages of Brown Patch fungus on some of the lawns throughout the community. This fungus appears as brown patches and splotches in the grass. If the area receives too much moisture from rain or irrigation the brown area begins to spread turning a yellow greenish color around the edges and advancing toward a reddish color.

THE FIX:

We can do little about the rain, but we can adjust our irrigation systems to only water 1 time per week. Rusticscapes asks that all homeowners make this adjustment as soon as possible. The day you choose to water should be the day after your yard is mowed. If we have rain even one day in any week homeowner should skip watering completely for that week.

- Stay indoors at Dusk/Dawn.

PLEASE WEAR A FACEMASK TO ENTER THE ANNEX & CLUBHOUSE Use of the gym and exercise facilities is limited to homeowners and registered residents (this being defined as renters or lessees, adult children or grandchildren who are permanent residents in the home and who have been registered with the office).

The maximum occupancy is limited to 5 because of recommended social distancing. The hours of operation will continue as normal under our Rules and Regulations with access by your remote key fob.

Masks are required to enter the clubhouse but do not have to be worn while exercising. Please continue to bring your own disinfecting supplies. Please wipe



off all equipment prior to use and after use.



Yard Art:

Yard art shall be permitted in the front/side yard under the following conditions:

- a. Location: Art must be an integral part of the landscaping and blend in with the existing shrubbery or trees.
- b. Size: Yard art shall not exceed thirty-six (36) inches in height. The exception is decorative landscape planters used for the display of *living* flowers or other approved landscape material.
- Materials: Decorative accessories and landscape planters must be constructed of durable materials.
- d. Maintenance: All accessories shall be maintained in such a fashion as to not detract from the neighborhood. Landscape planters must be maintained with *living* landscape materials at all times.

Homeowners, we are entering into a very contentious election cycle There are specific Texas state statutes which govern the placement of political signs which the HOA cannot override; however, there is also specific language about lewd and offensive language which the signs cannot violate.

We want to be respectful of everyone's right to vote as their conscience dictates, but we also do not want to turn our beautiful community into a warring faction of political ideology that might be different than your own. With that being said 4X6 political signs are allowed in your private yards based on specific state guidelines. Signs placed on common property of BellaVita or street easements are not allowed. If you have placed a sign outside your private property, please remove or it will be removed and properly disposed of.

The Awards Committee would like to announce Q3 2020 Volunteer of the Quarter,

Barbara Gorman and Mickey Kinzer. The Volunteer of the Quarter is a program to publicly recognize the efforts of an individual for BellaVita community service. This Quarter the Awards Committee has selected 2 volunteers since they work in tandem with each other.

Barbara Gorman and her husband Jim moved to BellaVita in December 2001. Barbara started the library in 2003 soon after the Clubhouse opened with books from her own collection. The library grew quickly because of donations from BellaVita residents and the bookshelves in the long hallway of the clubhouse and the computer room were used in addition to the shelving in the TV room. When the Annex opened, Barbara was instrumental in getting the library moved to the annex and arranged for the Paterno brothers to build and install shelving for the rapidly growing collection. Since the library has grown, due to continued donations by residents, additional shelving had to be purchased.

Barbara has arranged to take anything that can't be used, to Half Price Books for possible sale. As a result of these sales, the library has been close to self- supporting. Through these funds, smaller things such as the magazine rack, movie shelving, bookends, small bookcases and many books have been obtained. Barbara says with the assistance of several loyal volunteers including Carol Grisanti, Don Talley, Mary Hearn, Sunny Ward, Mickey Kinzer and the Clubhouse committee, the library's operation and updates have been achieved.

In addition to Barbara's dedication to the BellaVita Library, she has volunteered as an instructor for yoga and pilates, 2004-2014 (3 days/week) and gentle yoga, 2019. She has participated on the HOA Clubhouse Committee and as a Block Captain since 2004. Her volunteer efforts also include the Art group, Party Bridge, and Bowling group.

We would also like to recognize Mickey Kinzer this quarter along with Barbara. Mickey moved to BellaVita in September 2001. After she retired, she began to volunteer in the library in 2018. Her assistance has been greatly appreciated at the library. She made the book shelf labels that help everyone find what they need and makes shelving books much easier. Mickey likes to decorate and introduced flowers and seasonal decorations for the library. She also makes regular trips to Half Price Books when boxes of duplicate and rejected books have accumulated. When the library was painted, and new carpeting installed; she coordinated volunteers to move the books out and then back into the library. Mickey not only has a love of books, she also loves animals, especially dogs. In 2015, she organized a BellaVita Dog Lovers group and in 2017, she and her Border Collie started a BellaVita Dog Play Date group.

Due to the pandemic, the clubhouse and the library were closed. Mickey created a "BellaVita Library Al Fresco" which was books on the porch outside the annex. However, that had to be closed, so Mickey took it upon herself to take books, puzzles, etc. to her home and opened her garage as a satellite library for residents. When the library was opened again with some new safety regulations in place for residents, Mickey communicated to residents via BellaVita Facebook Group- Grapevine that they were open.

Barbara and Mickey see the library as an important addition to our community. They work toward improving and updating the collection for all BellaVita residents. They have done an incredible job in all their volunteer efforts. Thank you, Barbara and Mickey, for all your hard work. Please congratulate them on their outstanding contributions and recognition as Volunteers of the Quarter.



- Over 400 pages one week copying
- Any specialty services (stapling, binding, hole punching, etc.) are the responsibility of the requester.
- All copies are black and white on white paper only.
- All specialty papers are to be provided by the requester.

ARCHITECTURAL GUIDELINES REMINDER:

Remember to check the Architectural Guidelines before making any improvements or modifications to the exterior of your home or property. There are specific requirements for many changes.

The ARC Guidelines are on the BellaVita website along with an application which explains the time frame for approval and the documents required to be submitted.

The Rules and Regulations governing the use of BellaVita property (clubhouse, annex, pool and common grounds) state that no more than 10 guests per household are allowed. Exceptions to this rule are for Bereavement/Memorial services, private party rentals and events open to the public such as the Mistletoe Market. Your private homes are not governed by these Rules and Regulations.
