

Friends who devotedly held her hand and made her laugh as they regaled her with stories of their lives. Friends who safeguarded her memories and gave them back to her each time they met. They lovingly took this journey - her journey - with her. She was never alone. So, when at the end, she slipped away for the last time, she went "home" to Galveston.... if only in her mind.

'Go rest on high on that mountain, (Ondree), your work on Earth is done.' You have left a legacy of joy and laughter. We will carry you in our hearts, forever.

Ondree leaves behind a daughter and son, two nieces, a cousin, numerous loving friends and a team of extraordinary doctors and caregivers who worked tirelessly to ensure she lived her best life till the very end. She will be laid to rest next to her mother and father in a private graveside service at Galveston Memorial Park in Hitchcock, Texas. 

Safety Tips

- 1. Use ATMs in well lighted, populated areas. When using an ATM please be extra cautious of your surroundings and don't count your money out in the open. Avoid carrying large amounts of cash.
- 2. When exiting/unloading your vehicle be cautious of anyone in the vicinity. If you see a suspicious person stay in the vehicle with your doors locked and windows up. Never open your doors to anyone you do not know.
- 3. Always be aware of your surroundings, with interest to individuals near and around you.
- 4. When leaving your vehicle, lock it and close the windows. Don't leave valuables in public view.
- 5. Never leave your car running and unoccupied.

Tips for Packages

- 1. Sign up for delivery alerts so you know when your delivery is scheduled and when the package has been delivered.
- 2. If you're not able to be home when a package will be delivered, ask a trusted neighbor to hold it for you.
- 3. If possible, require a signature for all deliveries.
- 4. Be a good neighbor! If you see a package on your neighbor's doorstep, reach out and ask if they would like you to hold it until they are home.


