LANDSCAPING WORKORDERS - BACKLOG

From Connie Harry, HOA Board President

There is currently a 100+ backlog of landscaping workorders. The Board and the Grounds Committee are working with Maldonado on some alternative methods to assist in clearing the backorders, specifically, the irrigation orders as top priority.

Effective immediately, no workorders for any HOA contracted services other than irrigation and gutter cleaning will be accepted at the front desk until further notice.

For additional landscaping services, you are encouraged to hire a contractor of your choice. If you have outstanding workorders for anything besides HOA contracted services, you should contact Maldonado regarding the status of completion or you may hire someone else.

As in all previous HOA contracts for landscape, backyards continue to be a contract between the homeowner and either Maldonado or any other company you may hire, except for HOA contracted maintenance irrigation services.

Please do not complete work orders for anything other than the above specified work and do not file duplicate workorders. This does not accomplish anything productive. We understand your frustrations and we are working to help in every way possible to clear the work orders while continuing basic mowing services per the contract.

OUR STAFF HAS NO CONTROL OVER MALDONADO, ITS EMPLOYEES OR WORK PERFORMED. THEY HAVE NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR LANDSCAPE SERVICES.

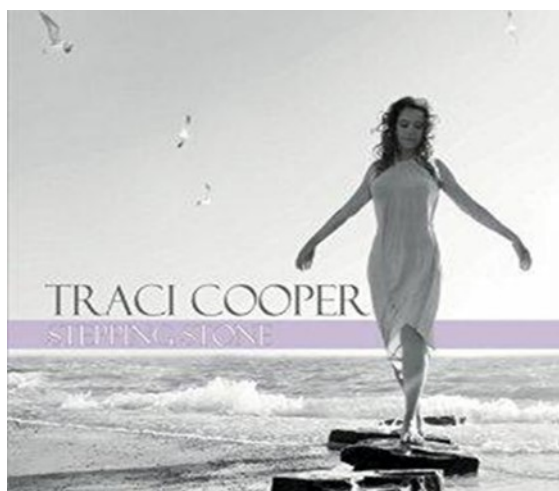

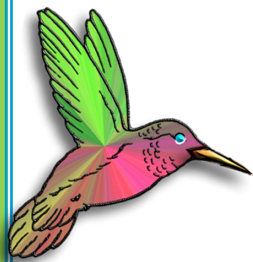

Maldonado Updates: 05-07-18

Front Yard - Complete.

Backyard Mulch and seasonal flowers - delayed again; last week should be started this week.

Weeds - A second crew is working its way through the subdivision this week to pull or treat weeds in the front yards and backyards of those homeowners who are receiving full service.

Ant Treatments- Residential and common area treatment is ongoing.

Irrigation Work Orders: Maldonado irrigation staff contacted 74 homeowners last week. Small repairs were made on the spot while larger repairs are being estimated for approval by the HOA prior to commencement of work.

Communication with Maldonado: Currently the best form of communication with Maldonado is by a "Concern Form" submitted through the Clubhouse. Tracy is working through all the concern forms chronologically and some of them are repeats. Please do not submit multiple forms. Additionally, Maldonado is planning a subdivision wide mailout soon.

Front Door

Maintenance

Your HOA dues includes having your front door maintained every two years. This means the door will be lightly sanded and a light coat of spar varnish applied. A new weather strip at the bottom of the door is included if needed. This will help protect your door. However, if you postpone having the work performed and the door has to be refinished (not just maintained), the HOA will only cover a portion of the total cost of \$350. You will be responsible for a portion of the refinishing, depending on whether or not you need a weather strip. We will pay a maximum of \$130 (the cost to the HOA of a normal maintenance including a weather strip) and you will be responsible for the rest. So it will pay to have the work done every two years – and you are entitled to it. **Call the Front Desk (281-464-3150) and ask to have a Work Order made for “Door Maintenance”** if it’s been two years since it has been done.

The **Copy Center** copying guidelines for the BellaVita HOA Board, Board Committees and Clubs and Organization Officers are at no charge as follows:

- Maximum of 25 pages – immediate copying
- Maximum of 400 pages – 24 hour copying
- Over 400 pages – one week copying
- Any specialty services (stapling, binding, hole punching, etc.) are the responsibility of the requester.
- **All copies are black and white .**
- **on white paper only.**

All specialty papers are to be provided by the requester.

The Service Desk will provide the following FAX, Notary and copy services:

- Sending local Faxes – no charge
- Long distance faxes - \$1 for each page
- NO International faxes
- Receiving Faxes – 10 cents per page up to 25 pages and 25 cents per page over 25 pages.
- Notary services are free when a Notary is available. Notary services are for residents only.

NO OVER NIGHT STREET PARKING

12AM-5AM 7 DAYS A WEEK

VEHICLES WILL BE TOWED AT OWNER'S OR OPERATOR'S EXPENSE

The Villas Master Board of Directors passed a resolution in October defining overnight parking as midnight to 5am. The resolution states further that violators will be subject to fines and possible towing. BellaVita is a sub-set of Villas Master HOA so this resolution applies to our community. The BellaVita Board of Directors used this to streamline the compliance policy for BellaVita.

Starting August 1, 2016, the following procedure will be in effect for single or separate incident violations such as overnight parking:

- Law enforcement will randomly patrol all three Villa Masters' Communities.
- A friendly rules reminder will be physically attached to the violating vehicle.
- On the second violation a letter will be sent describing the violation, stating that a \$100 fine will be assessed the homeowner, and that the 3rd violation will result in the vehicle being towed at the owners expense.
- On the 3rd violation, the vehicle will be towed per the posted signs, see below, and to the towing service identified. The vehicle owner will be responsible for retrieving the vehicle and paying the required fees.

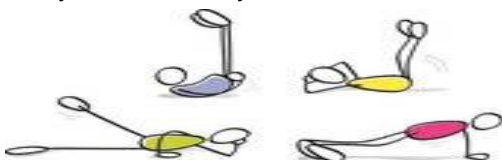
