DEED RESTRICTIONS, ARC GUIDELINES AND RULES/REGULATIONS OF BELLA VITA

When each of us chose to make BellaVita our home, we should have received, accepted, read and signed for specific documents relating to our deed restrictions, architectural guidelines and rules/regulations for the community. We agreed to abide by each of these documents to ensure that we can maintain the "over 55+ active community" atmosphere and keep our homes aesthetically in accord with the standard of BellaVita.

Over time or as newcomers, we sometimes forget or are not fully aware of some of these requirements.

There are very specific <u>deed restrictions</u> which are enforced through our partnership with Inframark, our management company, and legal representation.

There are specific <u>architectural guidelines</u> governing the improvements and/or modifications to the exterior of your homes and property which include but are not limited to landscaping which may involve drainage and easements, roof replacement, fence stain, window replacement, porches/pergolas, storage buildings, pools, satellite dish, solar panels, or other additions to the exterior of the property. There is an application on the BellaVita website or available at the front desk to facilitate the filing for such improvements/modifications. The timeframe for approval and the documents required are outlined on the application.

There are also <u>rules and regulations</u> adopted by the Board of Directors on behalf of the Homeowners Association which govern the use of the common properties, including the pool, annex, clubhouse and common grounds. These rules are in place for a reason to allow the greatest use by our residents while still allowing access for their guests for specific times and events.

All governing documents are available online through the BellaVita website at www.club-bellavita.org. Failure to comply on any of the governing documents will result in compliance letters being sent and ultimately may lead to fines being assessed against your home.

Please become familiar with the documents before you begin any work and if asked by the staff to adhere to an adopted rule, please comply. We love our community and work hard to maintain the highest standard while enjoying the good life that BellaVita offers.

NOVEMBER 2019 ELECTION

There is a very important matter on the upcoming November 2019 ballot which bears your consideration I am taking this information from a recent news article. Look for Texas Proposition 4.

LOOK AT NOVEMBER BALLOT CAREFULLY. TEXAS INCOME TAX? VOTE YES

"For the upcoming ballot in November: One of the items will be TEXAS INCOME TAX. If you don't want it, VOTE YES, if you do VOTE NO. (a YES vote supports the amendment to permanently ban a state income tax. If you vote NO – thinking you are voting against a state income tax - you are voting against the ban and are voting for a state income tax). CONFUSING as always.

Just let everyone know about this voting ballot. Texas doesn't have a State personal income tax. NOT YET. But there are people working to change that. On Tuesday, November 5, 2019, we can vote to protect ourselves against this tax."

BE INFORMED. The BellaVita Arts and Crafts Room will be a voting site on election day from 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Early voting begins October 21^{st.} You can vote at any voting location in Harris County. If an "SOR" sign is displayed, you may be required to fill out a Statement of Residency if you are not voting in your precinct.





APRIL JUNE AUGUST OCTOBER

Trimming occurs per the mowing schedule. For example, if your yard is mowed on Monday, your shrubs should be trimmed on one of the 4 Mondays during the month of October.

If a homeowner would like their front shrubs trimmed more frequently, an extra charge could be imposed.



The committee is comprised of volunteers from the Belles Club as well as any other residents of the community who would like to assist. BellaVita is a community committed to neighbors helping neighbors and this is just one small way in which we try to be a support in the loss of a loved one.

- Any specialty services (stapling, binding, hole punching, etc.) are the responsibility of the requester.
- All copies are black and white on white paper only.
- All specialty papers are to be provided by the requester.

ARCHITECTURAL GUIDELINES REMINDER:

Remember to check the Architectural Guidelines before making any improvements or modifications to the exterior of your home or property. There are specific requirements for many changes.

The ARC Guidelines are on the BellaVita website along with an application which explains the time frame for approval and the documents required to be submitted.

The Rules and Regulations governing the use of BellaVita property (clubhouse, annex, pool and common grounds) state that no more than 10 guests per household are allowed. Exceptions to this rule are for Bereavement/Memorial services, private party rentals and events open to the public such as the Mistletoe Market. Your private homes are not governed by these Rules and Regulations.
