



ROSE AWARD 2018 GOES TO LINDA KUHN

What is the ROSE Award?

ROSE is an acronym for Recognition Of Serving Extraordinarily.

The ROSE is the highest form of recognition given by the BellaVita HOA to a person for an idea/solution/project that occurred in the prior year, 2018, and that directly benefits the entire BellaVita community and/or community life. These efforts are viewed as being "above and beyond" the normal service of homeowners.

Based on the ROSE Award criteria,

The Rose Award 2018 recipient has provided valuable ideas, has helped identify solutions which has benefitted and improve the community; all with a standard of professionalism and community spirit.

The 2018 Rose Award recipient's professional background, knowledge of environmental issues, and love of wildlife both enable and inspires this person to serve the BellaVita community. By using her remarkable skills, Linda serves in a unique way which really benefits all residents.

Linda Kuhn has been an active member of the Grounds Committee for several years. Now, serves as an inspiring chairperson of the Nature Reserve Committee. Leads the committee that maintains the Harry Reed Audubon Trail and the Nature Reserve.

In 2018, Linda devised and implemented a novel project that will benefit all BellaVita residents. She has been the driving force in creating a Nature Observation Platform at the end of Ameno Drive. This project improves the aesthetics of our community. It encourages the use of and ease of access to the Nature Reserve for all residents who do not or cannot access the Nature Reserve trails. Now it has been designed by Linda, taking into consideration ADA requirements. The project has three defined phases:

Phase 1: Via Linda's direction, the volunteers joined to bring to fruition a butterfly/hummingbird garden at the end of Ameno Drive. Cheerful butterfly benches (donated) and decorative boulders and border stones have been installed to make quite a statement. In the garden, native vegetation has been chosen to attract butterflies. Now a lovely spot for residents to sit and take in nature.

Phase 2: To remove and replace the unsightly barricade at the end of Ameno Drive. This is definitely an improvement to the aesthetics of the environment since the barricade is being replaced with large natural boulders and an entrance to invite all residents to enjoy the sights of our home habitat on the new Observation Platform.

Phase 3: Construction of the Observation Platform including built in seating and access boardwalk. She has solicited donations for funds from BV clubs and individuals for the platform. Donations are now over \$10,000. However, additional funds are needed to ensure the completion of construction. As the Nature Reserve Committee has communicated, large or small donations are appreciated.

As well as this large project, Linda has installed several Blue Bird boxes (made by the Girl Scouts and guided by the BV Birders). Also, she has installed Wood Duck boxes in the Nature Reserve which have produced eggs.

Linda has nursed birds, squirrels, screech owls and other local animals back to health. The survival of the creatures who share our environment is very valuable to us in keeping our ecosystem sound. Even the front desk and others know who to contact when a creature is in distress.

For tireless dedication and caring efforts to the environmental improvements of the BellaVita community, we recognize Linda Kuhn as the Rose Award 2018 winner.

PLEASE DO NOT FEED THE STRAY ANIMALS!

By feeding stray cats, racoons, opossums, etc., you create unwanted messes in your yard and your neighbors yards. Stray cats that are being fed tend to make litterboxes out of gardens, plants, rooftops, patio furniture, and worse, garages. Feral cats can also damage outside furnishings by scratching and spraying on them, leaving an unpleasant odor. Neighbors with damage from these strays may use necessary means to remove the unwanted pests to avoid further damage by calling Animal Control or using an animal safe trap. Traps are often available at no charge from the City.

The Rules and Regulations governing the use of BellaVita property (clubhouse, annex, pool and common grounds) state that no more than 10 guests per household are allowed. Exceptions to this rule are for Bereavement/Memorial services, private party rentals and events open to the public such as the Mistletoe Market. Your private homes are not governed by these Rules and Regulations.

All specialty papers are to be provided by the requester.




