



Lots of snake reports some of which may be poisonous. Numerous inquiries have been made to Texas Parks and Wildlife, Animal Control, local game warden, and independent companies specializing in snake removal. All have said that the proximity of our lake to the Nature Reserve and Clear Creek make this a natural habitat and they cannot be removed by any agency. They recommended if you have a concern in your own yard there are repellents which can be administered or a private company can treat your property for a monthly charge beginning at \$75 per month.

If you or your family are fishing around the lake, be extra careful and observant.









Please be watchful where you park at the Annex.

There are only a few parking spots there, but most are for either Handicapped Parking or 15 minute parking. If you park there for Gym use and are there longer than 15 minutes, please park in larger lot.

Neighbors with damage from these strays may use necessary means to remove the unwanted pests to avoid further damage by calling Animal Control or using an animal safe trap. Traps are often available at no charge from the City.



DID YOU KNOW?

The Belles Club sponsors a Bereavement Committee to assist families with meal services on the death of a loved one in which the family wishes to use Clubhouse Facilities for a memorial reception.

The following are guidelines of the committee:

- Service offered only on the death of a resident;
- Family contacts the Clubhouse Manager to arrange for use of the clubhouse facilities;
- Clubhouse Manager contacts Bereavement Committee to assist family;
- Bereavement Committee provides salads, vegetable dishes, desserts, and tea/coffee/water. Family provides any other beverages of their choice;
- Bereavement Committee works with the clubhouse personnel and family on the set up and clean-up.

Sue Steik has graciously volunteered to serve as coordinator of the Bereavement Committee. The committee is comprised of volunteers from the Belles Club as well as any other residents of the community who would like to assist. You may contact Sue Steik if you wish to be on the list as a volunteer (281-464-9454).

All specialty papers are to be provided by the requester.




