Open Friday evenings till 10 p.m.


Closed Sunday








World War II Veteran Comes Home at Last

A League City family's wait is over. Navy Seaman 2nd Class Richard J. Thomson, 19, returned home to his family in League City, Texas, after his remains were identified by the Defense POW/MIA Accounting Agency (DPAA) this past March.

Richard was assigned to the USS Oklahoma, moored at Ford Island, Pearl Harbor. On December 7, 1941, his ship was torpedoed by Japanese aircraft and capsized - resulting in the death of 429 crewmen.

From December 1941 through 1944, Navy personnel recovered the remains of the deceased crew, which were subsequently interred in two cemeteries on the islands.

In 2015, the DPAA exhumed the USS Oklahoma Unknown remains for further testing. Advancement in DNA testing helped to identify Richard Thomson's remains so he could be returned to his family.

Members of BellaVita's Veterans Group honored Richard Thomson by attending the funeral services in League City on June 1, 2019. The photographs below also display a quilt of valor donated to the family by the BellaVita sewing group. This beautiful quilt was made by Marcia Ashline.

Feral cats can also damage outside furnishings by scratching and spraying on them, leaving an unpleasant odor. Neighbors with damage from these strays may use necessary means to remove the unwanted pests to avoid further damage by calling Animal Control or using an animal safe trap. Traps are often available at no charge from the City.

Snakes

BE AWARE

Lots of snake reports some of which may be poisonous. Numerous inquiries have been made to Texas Parks and Wildlife, Animal Control, local game warden, and independent companies specializing in snake removal. All have said that the proximity of our lake to the Nature Reserve and Clear Creek make this a natural habitat and they cannot be removed by any agency. They recommended if you have a concern in your own yard there are repellents which can be administered or a private company can treat your property for a monthly charge beginning at \$75 per month.

If you or your family are fishing around the lake, be extra careful and observant.





Front Door

Maintenance

maintained every 2 years. This means the door will be lightly sanded and a light coat of spar varnish applied. A new weather strip at the bottom of the door is included, if needed. This will help protect your door. However, if you postpone having the work performed and the door has to be refinished (not just maintained), the HOA will only cover a portion of the refinishing and replacing the weather strip. The HOA will pay \$130.00 (the cost to the HOA of a normal maintenance including the weather strip) plus an additional \$50.00 to cover the cost of a second coat of varnish. The homeowner will be responsible for the rest. So it pays to have the work done every 2 years, if needed. Please come to the Front Desk at the Clubhouse and ask to have a work order made for Door Maintenance if it has been 2 years since your door was maintained last.

All specialty papers are to be provided by the requester.




